Feeder cattle prices derived from local markets and USDA reports. Beef live cattle prices derived from futures with an even basis. Holstein live cattle basis assumed at -\$8.00/cwt for contracted sales. Open-market sales are exposed to the risk of a wider basis (up to or exceeding -\$35.00/cwt). All projections include daily yardage (\$0.40/day for TMR-fed and \$0.25/day for self-feeders) as well as miscellaneous costs to cover medicine, implants, bedding, etc. Animal performance is not guaranteed.
